WASHING INSTRUCTIONS for CONSTRUCTION TUX By: Guardian Fall Protection

Even though the Construction Tux is built to withstand rugged and tough conditions, please treat your garment as a fine washable when laundering.

Because of its uniqueness we recommend the following procedure when washing the Tux.

To remove most stains from Tux, hand wash using a clean rag with a mild cleanser. Do NOT use bleach

There should be only one section of the harness outside the shell of the Tux during washing; this will be the chest strap. Make sure the chest buckle is secure. Place the Tux inside a garment bag or old pillowcase. Wash your Tux with a small amount of soap and set your washing machine on the gentle cycle. Dry laying flat or hanging – DO NOT dry in dryer.

Do not leave washing machine unattended during washing process. Due to the weight of the tux, the machine tends to become unbalanced. It is best to place another garment or rug on opposite side of machine.
